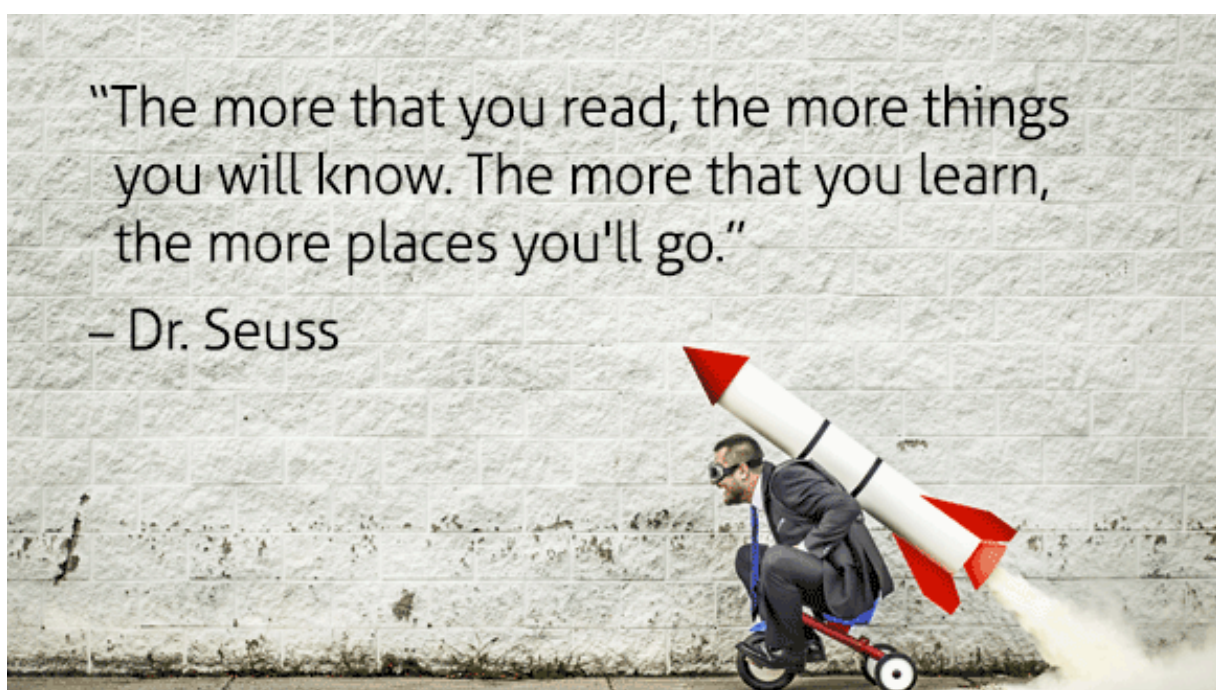

Please contact the Clinical team to request a case review on any youth who may potentially be placed out of home in a PRTF setting. This case review must take place prior to any additional reauthorization requests for a youth in a new PRTF placement.
