High Fidelity Wraparound (HFWA) is a planning process that follows a series of steps to help children and their families achieve their hopes and dreams. It helps make sure children and youth grow up in their homes and communities. This planning process brings people together from different parts of the family's life. Together they seek positive health outcomes for children with behavioral health needs.

Benefits to youth & families

Your child or youth may have a complex behavioral health condition. This might create challenges at home, at school, or in the community. Our approach helps children and youth stay with their families and be successful in school. We help them develop life skills and keep ties to their communities. We support their good health. We also help them prepare to become adults.

Your child/youth may qualify for these services if he or she:

- Is between the ages of 4 and 21
- Is eligible for Medicaid
- Has been involved in multiple systems
- Has received a specific behavioral/mental health diagnosis
- Has social or emotional challenges that impact his or her life
- Has a qualifying score on an assessment completed by a behavioral health provider
