## What are the benefits of HFWA?

Our approach helps children and youth:

- Stay with their families.
- Be successful in school.
- Develop life skills.

## Who can participate?

Your child/youth may qualify for our services if he or she:

- Is between the ages of 4 and 20.
- Is eligible for Medicaid.
- Has been involved in multiple systems.
- Has received a specific behavioral/mental health diagnosis.
- Has social or emotional challenges that impact his or her life.
- Has a qualifying score on an assessment completed by a behavioral health provider.

## Steps to enrollment

High Fidelity Wraparound will begin after the application and supporting documents have been reviewed and approved. This can take up to 14 days.

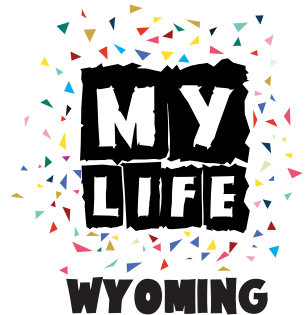
## Youth involvement

Youth may benefit greatly from participating in a program called MY LIFE (Magellan Youth Leaders Inspiring Future Empowerment):

- It's free.
- Offered to anyone, ages 13–23.
- Actively engages youth through teaching, coaching, and mentoring.
- Youth can learn how to use their voice.
- Youth can inspire others to create positive change for themselves and in their community.
